Earning high school CTS credits while gaining work experience through a part-time job,a Registered Apprenticeship Program, or Green Certificate



WORK EXPERIENCE

Have a part time job? Speak with your school counselor to sign up for work experience credits. These will count toward your high school diploma!!



REGISTERED APRENTICESHIP PROGRAM-RAP

The Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) is a great option for students interested in a career in the trades. RAP allows high school students to begin an apprenticeship training program as early as Grade 10. These students earn credit toward a high school diploma and a paid registered apprenticeship program at the same time.

WHAT IS DUAL CREDIT?



Students can register in postsecondary courses and earn high school credit as well as credit for the course at the college, university or technical school. You can get a head start on your career training!



GREEN CERTIFICATE

Offered at the high school level, students can acquire the attitudes, skills and knowledge needed to be successful in the agricultural sector. Students learn through actively participating under the direction of experienced farm personnel. Students may earn a Level 1 (Technician) Green Certificate and up to 16 credits.
